New Tree Protection Ordinance Legislation

The City of Atlanta Office of Zoning and Development distributed new Tree Protection Ordinance legislation. Proposed by councilmember Michael Julian Bond, Z-25-04 is a companion to 24-O-1691 and would:

- replace/update existing tree protection in the city
- · clarify how trees in the city are protected
- ensure proper management of trees in Atlanta's development and conservation efforts.

The legislation will be on the February 19 NPU-F agenda (<u>information to join here</u>). At the meeting, representatives from the Department of City Planning will be present to answer questions.

Alcohol Licence Application

Alcohol license application <u>ALCO-0125-36167</u> has been submitted for a new restaurant at 1620 Piedmont Ave, the location formerly proposed to be Toranj (which never opened) and which was Atmosphere before that. **The application is on the NPU-F agenda for vote this Wednesday, February 19.** Although the application was not received before our monthly MLPA board meeting - City Code does NOT require liquor license applicants to attend any neighborhood meeting(s) as a pre-condition to being heard by the NPU - applicant Jacob Isliker and his counsel had a call on Friday with MLPA Board representatives and the NPU-F Alcohol License Chair.

The new restaurant will be called Mistora and will serve tapas-style menu items with meat, vegetarian and seafood options, in addition to other small plates, entrees and desserts. There will be no live entertainment, no outdoor dining and no outside amplified music. Mr. Isliker is also the owner and operator (100%) of Verdure Kitchen & Cocktails on Dutch Valley Rd, also in Morningside; it has been open for two years and there have been no incidents nor violations of note. Mr. Isliker has agreed to change the closing operating hours to 11pm weekdays and 12am weekends. The later hours on the application were listed to account for the staff who remain after closing for cleaning, bookkeeping, etc.

If you are interested in learning more about this application and would like to vote, please attend the NPU-F meeting (<u>information to join here</u>), but also be aware that the applicant might defer as was requested in our meeting.


Piedmont Park Conservancy

Pre-K Lottery: If you have a child who will be 4 years old by September 1, 2025, be sure to apply for the 2025-2026 Atlanta Public Schools Pre-K Lottery.
